Director of The Center for Educational Technologies College of Veterinary Medicine & Biomedical Sciences Texas A&M University

The College of Veterinary Medicine & Biomedical Sciences (CVM) (<http://vetmed.tamu.edu/>) at Texas A&M University invites applications/nominations for a full-time, professor or associate professor, professional track or tenure track position at the College focusing on managing the Center for Educational Technologies (CET) by articulating a vision for the use of instructional technologies in the DVM curriculum, creating a strategic plan for the direction of the Center, and collaborating with the team to implement it. Additionally, the successful candidate will have a role in creating and implementing a sales and marketing plan and securing extra-mural funding to meet the Center's annual operating budget. The successful candidate will have a joint appointment in one of the five departments within the College, depending on the individual's area of interest and expertise. Qualifications for the position include an advanced degree (e.g., MS, MBA, PhD, DVM/VMD, MD) and experience in instructional technologies, pedagogy, and/or business operations. The successful candidate will articulate a vision for the use of instructional technologies in the DVM curriculum that is consistent with the mission of the College and University, and will be able to think in an innovative manner outside the norms of veterinary medical education. The candidate should have a demonstrated interest and/or expertise in instructional technologies, agricultural education, and/or adult education. Board certification and/or other advanced degrees will be considered a positive factor.

Requirements for the position include

- An advanced degree (e.g., MS, MBA, PhD, DVM/VMD, MD)
- A record of team management and project leadership
- Outstanding communication and interpersonal skills

Positive attributes

- Experience in academic or corporate administration
- Experience in online education and/or media development

It is expected that the successful candidate will

- Create an annual strategic plan for the CET and collaborate with the team to implement it
- Appropriately allocate resources to R&D of emerging instructional technologies
- Work with the Program Manager to ensure the financial wellness of the Center
- Secure extra-mural funding, including competitive grants and cooperative agreements
- Participate in CVM curricular efforts, as required
- Work effectively with students, faculty, staff, administrators, and former students
- Promote collegiality within members of the college

- Have demonstrated the ability to communicate in verbal and written formats
- Have administrative/management and conflict resolution experience
- Provide leadership
- Have an understanding of and experience with the mission of Land Grant institutions
- Serve as an outstanding advocate and spokesperson for the Center for Educational Technologies and the College of Veterinary Medicine & Biomedical Sciences
