## **Sampling Instructions:**

We need 30-50 pulled mane or tail hairs with the root follicle attached. You may use either mane, tail or both, whichever is easier. Hairs must be pulled straight out to ensure follicles come out of the skin. It may be best to pull 5-10 hairs at a time rather than larger amounts. Fill the form completely and at the bottom of the form or paper, tape the hair sample to the paper with clear tape, or just put the hair in the envelope with information on the outside. Do not tape over follicles. Extra hair can be trimmed. For single samples you can fold the paper and mail like a regular letter. If sending multiple samples, place each sample in an individual envelope/zip lock bag and put all envelopes in a larger envelope or box. You only need to fill in the boxes you know the information for.
