





Resources

Advantages

- Easy to set directly in Zoom session

Disadvantages

- Cannot track student response
- Limited to multiple choice questions
- Students in-person cannot participate unless they log into Zoom
- Polling for multiple sessions will be set up in single recurring Zoom session, so you will need to navigate between polls.

Summary

Decent option during fully-remote sessions to answer a simple question
