

## Oustanding Research Leader Award

### I. Purpose

The purpose of this award is to recognize a faculty member of the School of Veterinary Medicine & Biomedical Sciences (VMBS) who has a consistent record of outstanding extramural funding and publications with substantial impact in their research field.

### II. Eligibility

All VMBS faculty members at the rank of associate or full professor are eligible. Recipients of the award shall be ineligible for reconsideration.

### III. Nomination and Selection

Any faculty member who meets the eligibility criteria may be nominated by a fellow faculty member, Department Head, or Assistant/Associate Dean. Self-nominations will not be accepted.

The nomination should include the nominee's current CV and a 1-2 page cover letter that summarizes the nominee's consistent record of extramural funding and publications and their impact on the research field.

Nominations should be sent to [VMBSFacAwards@tamu.edu](mailto:VMBSFacAwards@tamu.edu) by **February 21, 2023**.

The Research Advisory Committee will screen the nominations and recommend up to 3 nominees to the School's Executive Committee for final selection and approval.

If no nominations are received, or if none of the nominees are determined to be worthy of the award, no award will be presented.

### IV. Award

Up to two awards will be presented each year. The award will be presented at the annual VMBS Honors & Awards ceremony and it will consist of a certificate and a check for \$500.
