

## Oustanding Young Faculty Research Award

### I. Purpose

The purpose of this award is to recognize an assistant professor who has joined the School of Veterinary Medicine & Biomedical Sciences (VMBS) within the past 3 years and has an excellent record of productivity, publications, and extramural research funding.

### II. Eligibility

All VMBS assistant professors who joined the school within the past 3 years are eligible. Recipients of the award shall be ineligible for reconsideration.

### III. Nomination and Selection

Any faculty member who meets the eligibility criteria may be nominated by a fellow faculty member, Department Head, or Assistant/Associate Dean. Self-nominations will also be accepted.

The nomination should not exceed 1 page and it should include a summary of the nominee's record of research productivity concerning publications and extramural funding since their joining the school.

Nominations should be sent to [VMBSFacAwards@tamu.edu](mailto:VMBSFacAwards@tamu.edu) by **February 21, 2023**.

The Research Advisory Committee will screen the nominations and recommend up to 3 nominees to the School's Executive Committee for final selection and approval.

If no nominations are received, or if none of the nominees are determined to be worthy of the award, no award will be presented.

### IV. Award

Up to two awards will be presented each year. The award will be presented at the annual VMBS Honors & Awards ceremony and it will consist of a certificate and a check for \$500.
